ICAS Daniel & Florence Guggenheim Memorial Lecture Award

He will deliver a lecture on “Collaboration Challenges in the Global Aerospace Market for Smaller Countries – an Australian Perspective”.

ICAS Lawrence Hargrave Award for Innovation in Aeronautics

Dr. Takashi Ishikawa – Japan

He will give an intense overview of “Full Composite Aero-Structures Development in Japan”.

ICAS von Kármán Award for International Cooperation in Aeronautics

Dr. Allan Paull – Defence Science & Technology Organisation, Australia; Mr Douglas Dolvin – Air Force Research Laboratory, USA; Dr. Kevin Bowcutt – Boeing Research & Technology, USA; and Prof. Michael Smart – University of Queensland, Australia

They will present on HIFiRE – the Hypersonic International Flight Research & Experimentation Program.

ICAS Maurice Roy Award

Mr Shinya Kobayakawa – Japan

This is awarded to a person of distinction who has an exceptional record in fostering international cooperation in the field of aeronautics.

ICAS John J. Green Award

Mr Evgueni Andreev – Russia

This is awarded to a young person of distinction who is demonstrating an exceptional record in fostering international cooperation between scientists, technologists and engineers by personal participation and involvement in aeronautics.
